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Manufacturers Technical Specification

The manufacturer's Technical Specification for protective clothing was based on EN ISO 15384:2020 "Protective clothing for firefighters – Laboratory test methods and performance requirements for wildland firefighting clothing" and EN 16689:2017 "Protective clothing for firefighters. Performance requirements for protective clothing for technical rescue". The suitability of this Technical Specification was checked with respect to the Essential Health and Safety Requirements of EU Regulation 2016/425, and was found to address the requirements for this end use.

The following clauses were excluded from the manufacturers Technical Specification:

EN ISO 15384:2020 Clause 6.3 (heat resistance)

The following items – touch & close fasteners and cuffs - used on the wildland suits do not meet the requirements for clause 6.3 when tested according to EN ISO 15384:2020 which states "Test each material including badges, patches, embroideries, rank markings, hardware and closure systems, including retroreflective and/or fluorescent materials separately. Carry out tests after the pretreatment as specified in 5.3. When tested in accordance with ISO 17493 at a temperature of (260 ± 5) °C, for 5 min \pm 15 s, no material shall melt, drip, ignite or shrink >10 %."

Whilst the hardware fails to meet the requirement as above, they did pass to the lower heat resistance temperature of 180°C and should be covered by compliant fabric when in use. The end user must decide on the basis of a risk assessment whether the use of this item is acceptable.

The knee assembly of the Trousers contains a "closed cell rubber sponge" material F26BL. This material also does not meet the requirements of Clause 6.3. Shrinkage of the F26BL was 13.8 % and 15.7 %. Testing was carried out with material F26BL exposed. In the garment this would be located inside the knee assembly. The end user must decide on the basis of a risk assessment whether the use of this item is acceptable.



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EN 16689:2017 Clause 7.9 Visibility

The garments do not meet the requirements of EN 16689:2017 Clause 7.9 for area of retroreflective and fluorescent material. The area of material on the submitted garments (size S Reg) was calculated as approximately 0.32 m^2 of retroreflective and 0.48 m^2 of fluorescent.

The end user must decide on the basis of a risk assessment whether the area and configuration of retroreflective / fluorescent materials is acceptable.

Limitations of Use

Usage, maintenance and storage as per manufacturer's instructions.

Observations

• The Fire Tunic together with Fire Trousers meet the minimum requirements for area of retroreflective and fluorescent material as required by Clause 9.2 of EN ISO 15384:2020.

- 13. The EC mark consists of the letters 'CE', in the form given in Annex II of Regulation (EC) No 765/2008 and for category III PPE, followed by the number of the notified body involved in production control monitoring (Module C2 or D).
- 14. This certificate does not authorise the use of the Mark of Conformity (the 'CE mark'), which may only be affixed to the above type approved equipment and a Manufacturer's Declaration of Conformity issued when Module C2 or D of the Regulation is fully complied with and controlled by a written agreement with a notified body.

Use of Notified Body Number
